### **Fr. Hal's Pastoral Perspective...**

*The Lord's Supper is a visible representation of the gospel message of mercy, which is demonstrated fully in the death of Jesus for our sins. It is for us a special remembrance of Christ's death and the hope of his glorious return. In the Catholic Church we believe in the real presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. We call our worship service "The Mass," and it is a celebration of Word and Sacrament. But let us not forget that something else happens: we experience a marvelous unity or community or fellowship among all Catholic believers. Our faith is strengthened through our fellowship with Christ and with other believers present in the church and elsewhere. We might ask: "What does the Lord's Supper mean?" The early Church tells us that Jesus celebrated the Lord's Supper on the night of the Jewish Passover. The Passover remembered deliverance from slavery in Egypt, and the Lord's Supper celebrates our deliverance from sin by Christ's death on the cross. Catholic Christians believe that when the words "This is my body," and "This is the cup of my blood," are spoken, the real presence of Christ replaces the inner substance of the bread and wine to become the body and blood of Christ. When we receive Jesus in Communion at a Catholic Mass, we respond by saying "Amen." This Hebrew word means, "I believe this is Christ", and I become more a part of the Body of Christ on earth, the Church. Through this new covenant (an agreement or solemn compact between members of a religious body and God) that Christ has given us, we can now personally approach God and live in communion with him. The old covenant was made on Mount Sinai between God and Israelites and was designated to point to the day when Jesus would come. The new covenant completes, rather than replaces, the old covenant. We are recommitting ourselves to this new covenant every time we proclaim God's Holy Word and receive Communion at the celebration of Holy Mass. The Gospel teaches us that whatever we have, if we bring it to Jesus, he will give thanks, he will bless it, and share it with others. And that is a central purpose of our life here on earth, nourishing others through him, in him.*

### **Q&As on the St. Joseph Cathedral Restoration**

Why does the Cathedral need to be restored? There is a great deal of basic infrastructure that needs attention. Every building requires maintenance, and the Cathedral is no exception. Much of the electrical system is original, now 90 years old. The sound system is inadequate, particularly for those who have hearing challenges. There are eight layers of paint that are peeling, plaster is deteriorating around some of our beautiful stained glass windows, and the floor needs attention. In this way alone, restoration is necessary.
